GUIDELINES FOR THE " PROF M.J. NARASIMHAN ACADEMIC MERIT AWARD CONTEST"

The contest is open to all the members of IPS under thirty-five years of age. All those interested in competing for the award should send abstracts (not exceeding 500 words of the research paper to the Society latest by the date indicated for this purpose in the announcement for the Zonal meeting. The abstracts of papers will be evaluated by a preliminary screening committee and only selected papers will be allowed to be presented at the Zonal meeting. The authors should also send the following certificate with the abstract.

Narasimhan Merit Academic Award contest for the year (2022) pertains to the major work done by the candidate It is further certified that the work has not been published and presented for any other award till date and contestant is below the age of 35 and member of the Society.

Following are the rules and regulations for the awards

1. The award will be given to the best paper presented at Annual Meeting of IPS.
2. All the contestants/recipients must be member of the IPS and under the age of 35 years.
3. The awards will be judged by a committee appointed for the purpose and their decision will be final.
4. The certificate for the award will be given only to the person presenting the papers.
5. The recipient of an award will be considered for subsequent awards only after a lapse of two years.
6. If the work presented relates to a thesis or award of any degree the concerned student should present the work and not the guide even though he/she may also be below the age of 35 years.
7. Preference would be given to work carried out under Indian conditions.
8. The time for the paper presentation is 15 minutes.

APS TRAVEL SPONSORSHIP FOR Ph.D. STUDENTS

In the agreement between APS-IPS on Feb 23, 2016, APS Travel Sponsorship for Students was instituted. The purpose of this award is to encourage plant pathology students pursuing a doctoral degree in India, who are members of IPS, to attend the APS Annual Meeting or other APS sanctioned meeting if deemed appropriate by the Indian Phytopathology Society and APS Foundation Board. The award has been established with contributions from Plant Pathologists of Indian Origin. Students will compete at the zonal competitions in India, and the awardee will be chosen from the top student presenters at these zonal competitions.

The terms and conditions for participating in APS meeting are as follows:

1. The fund will reimburse the awardee directly by APS for return airfare from India to the meeting venue, accommodation and incidentals.
2. The awardee is expected to bear the cost of meeting registration.
3. There will be no financial liability of the IPS.
4. All the contestant/recipients should be the member of the Society during the year of presentation.
5. The contestants will have to give a brief biodata, the certificate furnishing the age proof and proof of pursuing Ph.D. (First to Third year only) and one page a short paragraph, stating how participation in the APS meeting will lead toward achievement of their professional goals.
6. The award will be given to the best paper presented at Annual Meeting of IPS.
7. The awards will be judged by a committee appointed for the purpose and their decision will be final.
8. The award will be given only to the Ph.D. Student presenting the paper.
9. The time for the paper presentation is 15 minutes.
10. In service candidates are not eligible for this APS travel award

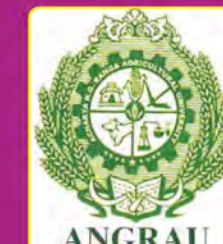

Guideline for Abstract Submission:

Participation in 2022 Central Zone Symposium on "Phytopathology for Sustainable Disease Management and Food Security" is open to all the Scientists, Faculty members and Research scholars. Abstract for oral or poster presentation should be maximum 250 words, including the title, authors and address. Abstracts should be prepared in MS- Word, Times New Roman, 12 font and single space leaving 1" margin on the left and right sides of the page. The technical session to which the abstract belongs must be clearly indicated at the top left of the abstract page and also in the registration form, e-mail ID and contact number of the corresponding author must be clearly given in abstract. However, it may be adjusted by the committee in other sessions based on the content of the abstract prepared. Abstract should be submitted on or before 10th October, 2022 in electronic form only by mail attachment to ipscentralzone2022@gmail.com Abstract will be printed only after receiving the registration fee. The acceptance will be communicated to the corresponding author by e-mail.

Guidelines for Oral/Poster presentation :

Oral/poster presentations will be organized into four different sessions. For oral presentation, each participant will have eight (8) minutes to present, followed by two (2) minutes for questions and answers from the judges and audience. For poster presentation, each participant will have five (5) minutes to present, followed by two (2) minutes for questions and answers from the judges and audience. During each session, a faculty moderator will introduce the students and keep track of the allotted time. All the Oral and Poster presentations will be judged by the Panel of experts. Certificate will be issued to the best presentations from each session.
